▶ Large Appliances

\$30 for each refrigerant type appliance that contains or contained refrigerants (refrigerators, freezers, etc.). No fee for non-refrigerant type appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, etc.). No dishwashers made of 50% or more plastic will be accepted for recycling.



Limit 3 per load. Appliances must be empty.

No commercial appliances.

▶ Clean Wood*

\$75.00 per ton, \$12.00 minimum fee (up to 320 lbs.)

Includes plywood, construction lumber (nails and staples are OK), oriented strand board (OSB), pallets, and lath (no plaster). No items longer than 8'



No painted, stained or treated wood. No metal hinges or latches.

▶ Yard Waste*

\$75.00 per ton, \$12.00 minimum fee (up to 320 lbs.)

Includes branches, brush, grass clippings, leaves, tree stumps, wood rounds, holiday trees, and weeds.



No plastic, plastic bags, glass, metal, sod, soil, or rocks. Branches: Maximum size 8' long, 4" diameter. Tree stumps, wood rounds: Maximum size 2'x2'x2'

▶ Scrap Metal* No charge

Includes aluminum, brass, copper, iron, and steel.



▶ Bicycles and Bike Parts

No charge

Some bikes and bike parts are refurbished by Bike Works, a nonprofit organization that educates youth and promotes bicycling. Other bikes and bike parts are recycled.



▶ Textiles No charge

Includes reusable as well as torn, worn, and stained clothing, curtains, fabric, linens, blankets, stuffed animals and throw rugs. Single socks and shoes are accepted.



No mattresses, box springs, carpet, or carpet padding. No wet or mildewed items. No items contaminated with hazardous materials.

▶ Fluorescent Light Bulbs and Tubes No charge

Limit 10 per person, per day.

These items are also accepted at Bothell's Wastemobile events.

▶ Medical Sharps No charge

Includes hypodermic needles, syringes and intravenous (IV) tubing with needles attached, scalpel blades and lancets that have been removed from original sterile packaging. Sharps must be in a puncture resistant, secured container labeled "sharps."

Place in designated bin.

Home generated sharps only.

No loose sharps.
