



RE-ROOF PERMIT APPLICATION

Online application submittal is required through www.MyBuildingPermit.com, select Building > Project Type > Re-roof

- Non-residential, mixed-use and multi-family re-roof applications require plan review prior to permit issuance.
- Single family re-roof permits are issued over-the-counter, upon verification of contractor's current city and state licenses.
 - Per the Bothell Municipal Code Title 20.02.095 (u), In-kind roofing overlays on one- and two-family dwellings provided the new layer results in a maximum of two layers are exempt from a Building permit.
- If roofing type to be applied is Torch Down or Hot Tar, a Fire Permit is **also** required (Hot Works Fire Construction permit). To apply for this permit, select Fire > Any Project Type > Special > Miscellaneous Installations. Miscellaneous Installation Type = Hot Work Operations.

 - **Scaled roof plan with installation notes and site plan or building satellite map.**
- Specifications on type of roofing being applied, and any underlying materials that will be applied prior to installation of the roofing materials.
- If listing is other than per International Building Code Section 1507, provide listing information/code report.

It is the applicant's responsibility to know the code requirements and provide all necessary information required for project review.
