First, please contact us seven to ten days after you have been appointed to our office. We can be reached by (1) telephone (numbers above) or (2) email. You can locate the appropriate email address by going to our firm website at **www.sbmhlaw.com**. In the upper right hand corner of our home page is a red link entitled “**CONTACT US**.” Simply click on that link. At the bottom of the **CONTACT US** page is an email for “**Present Criminal Defense Clients**.” Use this link to send us your name, address, phone number and email address. Please also include the court where your case has been filed, the crime of which you are accused, the cause number, if you know, and your next court date. This inbox is checked multiple times each day. Once received, one of our criminal law paralegals will forward your email to the appropriate attorney, and it will be received immediately, whether or not the attorney is in the office. You can also reach us by phone, and schedule appointments at one of our offices.

Keep in mind that after you are appointed we will serve the prosecuting attorney with a demand for discovery. At a minimum, this will allow us to get a copy of the police report. We ask that you also send us a written statement of your version of the events which resulted in the criminal charge, as well as any other information that you believe we should know about your case. In addition, notify us of the names, addresses, telephone numbers and birth dates of any potential witnesses, as well as a brief description of each witness’s knowledge concerning the facts of your case. Keep in mind that it is important that we identify potential witnesses as soon as possible so that we can ensure that they will be able to testify on your behalf. You can send this information by mail or use our website’s “**CONTACT US**” and “**Present Criminal Defense Clients**” links to send us this information, and for any future correspondence.

Our website itself includes information you may find useful concerning your case. For instance, the “**Legal Resources**” link on the up of the page provides access to information on Court Procedures, DUIs, Domestic Violence and Driving Offenses, including a link on how to get your driver’s license, as well as links to Bail Bonds Companies, Alcohol/Drug Treatment Centers, Locations of AA meetings, Washington State Criminal and Criminal Traffic Statutes. You can also get information about the firm, including biographies of our individual attorneys under the “**Attorneys**” link, and a sense of the type of criminal cases and other activities that we are involved with under the “**Case Results and News**” link, both of which can be found at the top of the page.
