

Water Bottle Jelly Fish

Time: 30-minutes

Goal(s): To encourage the reuse of materials

Promote new ways of thinking about art and the environment

Materials Needed – provided by school:

-Water Bottle for each students

-Scissors

-Hole punchers

-Balloon Ribbon

-Wiggly eyes

-Paint (optional)



Instructions:

- 1) Start by cutting the $\frac{1}{4}$ of the outer rim of the plate x2 one are the top and the other on the bottom
- 2) Paint or color all plate and one extra piece of plate you cut off
- 3) Use wiggly eyes or white construction paper/sharpie to cut out eyes and glue on plate with outer rims as ears
- 4) Use extra piece of paper plate and cut skinner to make elephant trunk and glue on.
- 5) Decorate with eyelashes or a bow

Paper Plate Alligator

Materials Needed – provided by school:

-2 paper plates

-Scissors

-Sharpie/black marker

-Glue

-Construction Paper (white and red)

-Wiggly eyes

-Paint – green and pink

Instructions:

- 1) Paint the backsides of both plates green.
- 2) Paint the inner side of one plate pink and folder this plate in half so pink is on the inside.
- 3) Cut white paper to make teeth. Cut out tongue from red paper. Glue tongue on the crease of pink and glue teeth on inside of pink
- 4) Apply glue on the bottom half of the green plate and glue on other green plate
- 5) Glue on the wiggly eyes or cut construction paper into eyes and use black marker for pupils
