Brief overview of the preferred alignment and proposed cross sections

Existing conditions

- Bike lanes in both directions and sidewalks
- 10' easement on private property for overhead power
- Existing illumination in the right of way

Proposed trail section

- Review of design standards and cross-sections (AASHTO: 5' buffer, 2' shoulders, 10' trail)
- Description of how trail would be placed relative to existing curb
- Description of how trail could extend around the stormwater pond
- Brief overview of other significant work related to the trail, including culvert and bridge work

Impacts to private property and overhead power

- About 6' of right-of-way acquisition along roadway frontage
- Relocation of the fence to new property limits
- Relocation of the overhead power into right of way
- Illumination would remain within right of way

What property owners can expect next

- Additional public meetings with more details about the culvert and bridge will be held in late 2017. Property owners will be invited.
- 30 percent design and environmental permitting happens next.
- Property owners could expect initial contact with right of way specialists in 2018/2019.
