



## Report a Crime Online - CopLogic

The Bothell Police Department's online crime reporting system allows you to submit a police report immediately and print a copy of the report for free. **If this is an emergency**, **please call 911.** Please confirm the following to find out if reporting a crime this way is right for you:

- This is <u>not</u> an emergency.
- This incident occurred within the Bothell city limits.
- There are <u>NO</u> known suspects.

If your situation meets all of the above criteria, you are ready to file your report. Please make sure to turn off your pop-up blocking software before filing the report. If you answered no to any of the questions, please look at our online crime reporting frequently asked questions section.

## Upon completion of this report process you will:

- See the words "Your online police report has been submitted" showing that your police report is complete.
- Be given a temporary confirmation number, and,
- After your report has been reviewed and approved, a case number and a copy of your police report will be sent to you by e-mail.
